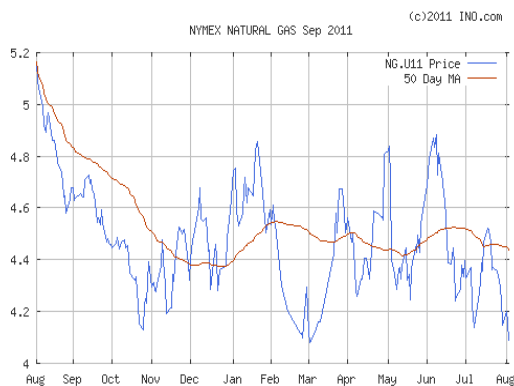

Market Natural gas traded mixed this week; but is much lower today after the storage report, sluggish economic reports and the stock market. Gas production levels due mostly to shale drilling are still strong; but shale fracking practice under some environmental scrutiny now. Natural gas is attractive to fix at this time to protect this year and beyond. The North American rig count is 877 this week. After a rise in count starting a year and a half ago the rig count has leveled off and decreased by 12 this week.

The Crude oil price for September is much lower this week at \$86.88 per barrel. Heating oil is lower at \$2.90 per gal. Unleaded gasoline futures are lower this week at \$2.75 and gasoline at the pump is around \$3.75...in Indiana. The natural gas storage report today was an injection of 44 BCF; but storage is 186 BCF lower than last year and 68 BCF lower than the 5 year average.



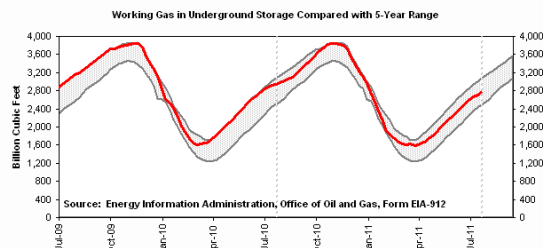
Above Graph – Sept 2011 NYMEX gas futures
